All those in attendance gave introductions. There were 16 members in attendance that ate 3 extra large pizzas.

Lynn Rogers (SSSCC club president), showed off the **new measuring wheel** he purchased for the club. This one is more durable than the ones that have been purchased in the past.

He announced that Bob has ordered **more wristbands**, but they may not be here in time for the next events. But we think we have enough to get by regardless.

The season schedule has been set (see below) so Mitch has re-designed the **promo cards** and ordered 2000 of them. 1000 cards with the schedule on the back and 1000 with only generic contact info on the back, to be used during the off-season.

There was some discussion on what to do with the **baseball tickets** the club had to purchase as part of our agreement with the Dust Devils Baseball team (for use of their parking lot). We will either give them away at events, or try and sell them to re-coop some of our cash outlay. Mark Rieb reported that the Dollar Store is all out of the little rolls of **blue tape**. So a discussion ensued about what other alternatives were available for putting numbers on a car.
